FEDERAL AGENCY ASSISTANCE

Inspector General Staff Attorney Kristi Shute, after monitoring by Special Agent Darrell Boehmer, reports as follows:

This report addresses the cooperation and readiness to provide assistance by the Office of the Inspector General (“OIG”) to an investigation by a federal agency. Similar to other law enforcement agencies, the OIG assists agencies upon request. The OIG is specifically authorized to cooperate with federal law enforcement agency investigations. IC 4-2-7-3(4)(B).

On February 26, 2013, a Special Agent with a federal agency notified the OIG about an investigation regarding questionable materials on Indiana projects and alleged false claims. The federal Special Agent requested potential OIG assistance in the investigation.

Assistance was pledged, but as of this date, no assistance has been requested. Therefore, we will close this investigation and stand ready to provide assistance in the future upon request.
