Inspector General Cynthia V. Carrasco reports as follows:

On May 27, 2015, a former state contract worker, with the Indiana Department of Corrections (“IDOC”), pled guilty to Theft, a Class D felony and was sentenced to serve 1091 days of probation and complete 50 hours of community service. The former contract worker was also ordered to pay restitution back to the State in the amount of Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and 00/100 (\$350,000).

The former contract worker’s conviction and sentencing was the end result of an investigation by the Indiana Office of Inspector General into alleged criminal acts by the contract worker involving the submission of falsified payroll invoices to receive payment for hours not actually worked.
