
**Brief Description of Item Solicited, Accepted, or Received and approximate Value:**

The Department is in the process of building a large prison compound on the grounds at Westville. There is a steel cell production facility in the state of Georgia, which will supply materials for IDOC's large-scale construction project. To facilitate this manufacture, one of the Agency's top construction service staff must visit to inspect and better understand the manufacture process. The Agency's selected subcontractor, Elevatus Design, is also traveling to this factory in Georgia in their company plane to inspect and approve and offered to take the DOC staff.

By accepting this offer to travel with the vendor, staff will save the agency up to \$1,000 dollars in travel expenses.
