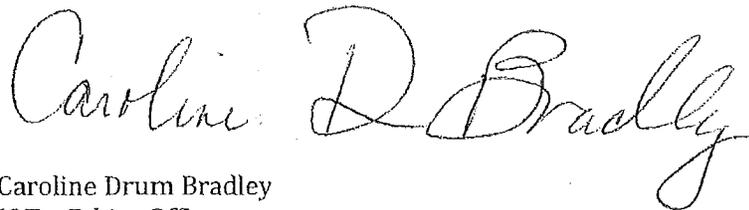
Nature of Business Relationship with Agency: Previously awarded vendor who provides mainframe infrastructure to the state.
