Nature of Business Relationship with Agency: The College Board is a non-profit organization that helps students prepare for a successful transition to college through programs and services in college readiness and college success through programs such as Advanced Placement and the SAT. State why acceptance is in the public interest: Indiana has a long-standing relationship with the College Board. Many of the secondary schools in Indiana offer AP courses which can be translated into course credit at all Indiana postsecondary institutions.
