To whom it may concern:

I was approached by my nephew Joshua Anderson in May 2015 about a conversation between him and Roy Haney at an IPA meeting. Joshua asked me if I knew anything about McGrady's pharmacy and why he was before the board because he was considering selling his store to Walgreen's. I told Josh that Mr. McGrady had failed to renew his DEA license and was told not to dispense controlled until the matter was resolved. I told Josh that when the DEA returned to the pharmacy McGrady had dispensed some controlled substances and at that time his DEA license was voluntarily surrendered. I did not go into details or Mr. McGrady's reasoning why he thought it was ok to dispense controlled substances.

In June 2015 Joshua asked me to have Mr. McGrady call him before he signed any papers Walgreens. At the June board meeting I told Mr. McGrady to contact Josh before he sold to Walgreens and Mr. McGrady said he would and asked for Josh's cell phone number in which I provided.

Joshua Anderson, Lester Burris and myself had a meeting later in June about purchasing McGrady's pharmacy. Mr. McGrady's business was declining at a rapid pace and he was unable to pay his bills and was near closing his doors. This is when McGrady entered into a central fill contract with Panacea pharmacy in Bloomington which is owned by Joshua Anderson, Lester Burris and myself. This contract is valid until Anderson Burris Inc. completes the acquisition of McGrady's pharmacy.

I have recused myself from any vote pertaining to Mr. McGrady and McGrady's Family Pharmacy since these events as noticed in the July minutes of the Indiana Board of Pharmacy meeting.
