

RESOLUTION 1996- 17

A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR THE AUTHORITY TO GRANT TEMPORARY SUPPLIER'S LICENSES

The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") adopts the following resolution pursuant to the authority granted to it under IC 4-33 and pursuant to 68 IAC 1-2-6.

The following factors have been considered by the Commission:

1. Numerous Certificate of Suitability holders have projected opening dates in the spring and summer months.
2. Companies that will be supplying these Certificate of Suitability holders with products and services have applied for a supplier's license and a background investigation has been initiated by the Indiana State Police, Gaming Enforcement Section.
3. The Commission may not have business meetings scheduled during the spring and summer months at times when it can issue additional necessary temporary supplier's licenses.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDIANA GAMING
COMMISSION, THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED:**

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS.

The definitions set forth in IC 4-33-2 and 68 IAC apply to this resolution.

SECTION 2. GRANT OF AUTHORITY TO EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO ISSUE TEMPORARY SUPPLIER'S LICENSES.

Recognizing the need to issue temporary supplier's licenses prior to the business meetings scheduled during the spring and summer months, and in an effort not to delay the opening of the riverboats, the Commission hereby authorizes the Executive Director to issue temporary supplier's licenses to suppliers deemed necessary to provide products to these riverboats prior to the opening date of the respective riverboat upon a determination by the Executive Director that the preliminary investigation has been completed and does not reveal information that would deem a company unsuitable for licensure. Each issuance of a temporary supplier's license by the Executive Director shall be reported to the Commission at the next scheduled business meeting. The Commission may affirm the action of the Executive Director, may revoke the temporary supplier's license, or may direct the Executive Director to take additional or different action with respect to a temporary supplier's license. The temporary

supplier's license will remain valid until the date that the permanent supplier's license is issued or until the temporary supplier's license is revoked pursuant to 68 IAC 2-2.

SECTION 3. CONDITIONS PLACED ON TEMPORARY SUPPLIER'S LICENSE AND GRANT OF AUTHORITY TO EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO PLACE ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS ON THE TEMPORARY LICENSE.

(a) The Commission hereby places the following conditions on each temporary supplier's license issued in section 2:

1. That the temporary supplier licensee pay all costs associated with the completion of the background investigation to the extent the amount exceeds the application fee that was paid pursuant to IC 4-33-7-1 and 68 IAC 2-2-2.
2. That the temporary supplier licensee sign an affidavit acknowledging the conditions that are placed on the issuance of the temporary supplier's license.

(b) The Commission hereby grants to the Executive Director the authority to place additional conditions on the issuance of the temporary supplier's license, including but not limited to, the following conditions:

1. That the temporary supplier licensee comply with the conditions set forth in paragraph (a) above.
2. That the temporary supplier licensee maintain the records set forth in IC 4-33-7-5 and furnish the information set forth in IC 4-33-7-5 to the Commission.
3. That the temporary supplier licensee maintain its records in a manner consistent with Commission directives pursuant to IC 4-33-4-6.
4. That the temporary supplier licensee obtain, maintain, or both, insurance in a minimum amount determined by the Executive Director. The temporary supplier licensee shall obtain, maintain, or both, the following types of insurance:
 - (A) Liability.
 - (B) Casualty.
 - (C) Capital loss.
 - (D) Fire.
 - (E) Theft.

- (F) Worker's compensation insurance.
 - (G) Any other type of insurance the Commission or the Executive Director deems necessary to ensure the temporary supplier licensee is adequately insured.
5. That the temporary supplier licensee continue to cooperate fully with the Indiana State Police Gaming Enforcement Section in the completion of the background investigation.
 6. That the temporary supplier licensee comply with all rules and resolutions that are adopted by an under which the Commission operates pending final promulgation of the rules.
 7. That the temporary supplier licensee continue to maintain suitability for licensure set forth in IC 4-33 and 68 IAC and that the temporary supplier licensee continue to comply with all requirements set forth in IC 4-33 and 68 IAC.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This RESOLUTION is effective immediately.


