The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") adopts the following resolution pursuant to the authority granted to it under IC 4-33 and pursuant to 68 IAC 1-2-6.

The following factors have been considered by the Commission:

- 1. The Commission has begun promulgation of these rules, or plans to begin promulgation of these rules pursuant to IC 4-22. All of these rules are to be published in the *Indiana Register* as soon as all of the statutory requirements of IC 4-22 are met. A public hearing is to be held on these rules in compliance with IC 4-22.
- 2. The promulgation process for the final promulgation of these rules will take a minimum of four (4) to six (6) months.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION, THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED:

SECTION 1. SCOPE.

This resolution applies to each applicant, each licensee, each riverboat license applicant, any person who does business with an applicant or licensee, and any person who is a patron of a Riverboat Gambling Operation.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS.

The definitions set forth in IC 4-33-2 and 68 IAC apply to this resolution.
