SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") by and through its Executive Director Ernest E. Yelton and Belterra Casino and Resort ("Belterra") (collectively, the "Parties") desire to settle this matter prior to the initiation of a disciplinary proceeding pursuant to 68 IAC 13-1-18(a). The Parties stipulate and agree that the following facts are true:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Pursuant to 4-33-9-12, "a person who is less than twenty-one (21) years of age may not be present in the area of a riverboat where gambling is being conducted." Pursuant to 68 IAC 1-11-1(c), "[a] person under twenty-one (21) years of age shall not be present on a riverboat."
- 2. On June 15, 2006 a woman at a blackjack table was discovered to be under twenty-one (21) years of age.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Commission staff contends that the acts of Belterra as outlined herein constitute a breach of IC 4-33, 68 IAC and Belterra's approved internal control procedures. Under these circumstances, the Commission and Belterra have determined that in lieu of the Commission pursuing formal disciplinary action against Belterra, Belterra shall pay a fine of \$4500.

Upon execution and approval of this Settlement Agreement, Commission staff shall submit this Agreement to the Commission for review and final action. Upon approval of the Settlement Agreement by the Commission, Belterra agrees to promptly remit payment in the amount of \$4500 and shall waive all rights to further administrative or judicial review.

This Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties. No prior or subsequent understandings, agreements, or representations, oral or written, not specified or referenced within this document will be valid provisions of this Settlement Agreement. This Settlement Agreement may not be modified, supplemented, or amended, in any manner, except by written agreement signed by all Parties.

This Settlement Agreement shall be binding upon the Commission and Belterra.
