ORDER 2007-37

AN ORDER DENYING THE APPLICATION FOR OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE OF DEBORAH SLONE CA-DEN-07-01

The Commission has considered the following factors:

On or about September 30, 2006, Deborah Slone was issued a level 2 temporary occupational license to work as a Cage Cashier at Caesar's Casino. Ms. Slone disclosed one arrest in Florida on her application for an occupational license. A background investigation by Commission staff discovered Ms. Slone had also been arrested in Kentucky. Commission staff sent Ms. Slone a letter requesting court documentation showing the outcome of the arrests. Ms. Slone did not submit the requested court documentation. The Commission staff requested Ms. Slone's records from the Kentucky State Police.

A review of the documents from Kentucky disclosed Ms. Slone was convicted of several felony offenses in Pike County, Kentucky in 1989.

The Commission staff revoked Ms. Slone's temporary occupational license and issued notice of denial of her application for a permanent license due to her felony convictions, as required by statute and by Commission regulations. She was informed of the opportunity to request a waiver of the felony disqualification and advised of the due date for the request. She did not respond by the due date and the Commission staff has had no further contact with Ms. Slone.

Based on the foregoing, the Commission hereby **DENIES** the Application for Permanent Occupational License of Deborah Slone.
