ORDER 2007-69

AN ORDER DENYING THE APPLICATION FOR OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE OF LISA JACOBS FL-DEN-07-10

The Commission has considered the following factors:

On or about February 21, 2007, Lisa Jacobs was issued a level 3 temporary occupational license to work as a Steward at French Lick Resort Casino. Ms. Jacobs indicated on her application for an occupational license that she had not been arrested. She did not disclose an arrest and conviction for a felony of Maintaining a Common Nuisance in Marshall County, Indiana in 1992. This conviction was discovered and confirmed by the Commission staff.

The Commission staff revoked Ms. Jacob's temporary occupational license and issued notice of denial of her application for a permanent license due to her felony conviction, as required by statute and by Commission regulations. She was informed of the opportunity to request a waiver of the felony disqualification and advised of the due date for the request. She did not respond by the due date and the Commission staff has had no further contact with Ms. Jacobs.

Based on the foregoing, the Commission hereby **DENIES** the Application for Permanent Occupational License of Lisa Jacobs.
