## ORDER 2010-126 RE: L&P INCORPORATED

The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") hereby issues this Order approving the attached Settlement and Release Agreement. In support of this Order, the Commission states as follows:

- 1. L&P Incorporated ("Respondent") is an Indiana corporation located in Rushville, Rush County, Indiana.
- 2. In February of 2008, the Gaming Control Division conducted an investigation of Respondent's warehouse and searched and seized certain property and money belonging to Respondent.
- 3. In lieu of an administrative prosecution by the License Control Division, Respondent and Commission staff agreed on a settlement in this matter and on June 9, 2010, entered into the Settlement and Release Agreement.
- 4. Respondent agrees to reimburse the Gaming Control Division for its investigatory costs associated with the February 2008 search and seizure. The Gaming Control Division agrees to return to Respondent any money in excess of its investigatory costs and any non-contraband property seized during the search. The Gaming Control Division will cause to be destroyed any contraband property seized during the search.

## **COMMISSION ACTION**

Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the proposed terms of the Settlement and Release Agreement.
