ORDER 2010-193

AN ORDER AFFIRMING BARBARA J. BURNETT'S PLACEMENT ON THE EXCLUSION LIST

On May 6, 2010, the Executive Director took action pursuant to IC 4-33-4-7(a) to exclude Barbara J. Burnett from all gambling facilities in Indiana as a result of Ms. Burnett taking unauthorized possession of a TITO worth approximately \$887 from another patron while at the Horseshoe Hammond Casino in Hammond, Indiana.

On May 18, 2010, Barbara Burnett filed with the Commission a request for review of the Executive Director's decision. On August 13, 2010, Commission Staff filed a Motion for Issuance of a Proposed Order of Default Judgment as a result of Burnett's failure to respond to the Administrative Law Judge's directive regarding her intentions to continue the appeal. On August 14, 2010, the Administrative Law Judge issued a Proposed Order of Default Judgment, to which Burnett failed to respond. On October 29, 2010, the Administrative Law Judge issued an Order for Default Judgment and issued Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

COMMISSION ACTION

After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with IC 4-21.5-3-29, the Commission hereby:

AFFIRMS

the Administrative Law Judge's Order. Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-6, this Order will become effective fifteen (15) days after it is served.
