ORDER 2010-194

AN ORDER AFFIRMING THE REVOCATION OF KENNITA F. COLE'S OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE

Ms. Kennita F. Cole was issued a permanent occupational license on January 29, 2008, which was renewed in 2009 and 2010. On July 26, 2010, Ms. Cole pleaded guilty to Endangering Children, a level 3 Felony. In order to maintain suitability for licensure, an occupational licensee may not be convicted of a felony under the laws of the State of Indiana or the laws of any other state or jurisdiction.

On August 10, 2010, the Commission filed a disciplinary complaint seeking to revoke Cole's occupational license due to her failure to maintain suitability. Cole failed to file an answer to the Commission's complaint. On October 12, 2010, the Commission made a Motion for Issuance of Proposed Order of Default Judgment as a result of Cole's failure to file an answer. On October 13, 2010, a Proposed Order of Default Judgment was served on all parties in this matter pursuant to I.C. 4-21.5-3-24(a)(1). On October 29, 2010, the ALJ granted the Commission's Motion and issued an Order for Default Judgment.

COMMISSION ACTION

After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with IC 4-21.5-3-29, the Commission hereby:

<u>AFFIRMS</u>

the Administrative Law Judge's Order. Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-6, this Order will become effective fifteen (15) days after it is served.
