## ORDER 2010-198 ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION RENEWING THE RIVERBOAT OWNER'S LICENSE OF AZTAR INDIANA GAMING COMPANY, LLC

In accordance with and subject to Indiana Code 4-33 and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code, the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") issued a Riverboat Owner's License to Aztar Indiana Gaming Company, LLC ("Aztar") on December 5, 1995, with an effective date of December 8, 1995. The most recent renewal, granted on November 9, 2006, extended the license to December 4, 2007.

On November 29, 2007, under the delegation of authority granted by the Commission on April 7, 2003 in Resolution 2003-13, and in anticipation of renewing Aztar's license at the March 31, 2008 Commission meeting, the Executive Director extended Aztar's license until such time as the Commission was able to consider Aztar's request at a Commission meeting. In Order 2008-37, however, the Commission appointed and designated an Attorney-in-Fact to conduct riverboat gambling operations and related activities at Aztar's Indiana casino. Due to the existence of the Attorney-in-Fact and related conditions, the Commission has not been able to consider Aztar's request for renewal until now.

On October 12, 2010, Aztar requested renewal of its riverboat owner's license and submitted payment of the annual renewal fee in the amount of five thousand dollars (\$5,000).

## **COMMISSION ACTION**

Pursuant to Indiana Code section 4-33-6-12, the Commission has found that Aztar has substantially complied with the directives of Indiana Code 4-33 and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code and is suitable to hold a Riverboat Owner's License. The Commission **GRANTS** renewal of Aztar's Riverboat Owner's License for a period of one year subject to Aztar maintaining its riverboat gambling operation, riverboat, hotel, and pavilion in substantial compliance with all applicable state and local laws, including but not limited to, Commission regulations, resolutions, orders and/or other directives relating to the riverboat owner's license, or to the lawful operation or conduct of gaming in Indiana. The renewal of the riverboat owner's license shall be valid for a period of one year from December 5, 2010 to December 4, 2011. According to IC 4-21.5-3, this order is effective fifteen (15) days after the order is served.
