

ORDER 2012-31

AN ORDER REGARDING THE REQUEST FOR HEARING REGARDING THE VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION REMITTANCE OF JOHN DOE #11-102

On November 10, 2011, in Order 2011-225, the Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) approved remittance of \$1,372.50 seized from John Doe #11-102 for the reason that John Doe #11-102 was a participant in the Voluntary Exclusion Program at the time he possessed monies while in the gaming area of the Hollywood Casino in Lawrenceburg, Indiana.

Subsequently, John Doe #11-102 filed with the Commission a request for a hearing on Order 2011-225. On January 9, 2012, Commission staff agreed to settle the appeal with John Doe #11-102.

COMMISSION ACTION


After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with 68 IAC 7-1-15, the Commission hereby:


