## ORDER 2012-35 AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION CONCERNING THE TRANSFER OF AN OWNERSHIP INTEREST IN DIGIDEAL CORPORATION

The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") adopts the following order pursuant to authority granted it under IC 4-33.

DigiDeal Corporation ("DigiDeal") is licensed by the Indiana Gaming Commission as a supplier. DigiDeal designs and sells electronic table games.

On March 28, 2011, DigiDeal notified the Commission that in December 2010, shareholder Randy Sines had sold his shares to Maryanne Snyder, giving Ms. Snyder a minority ownership interest in DigiDeal.

Pursuant to 68 IAC 5-2-2, transfers of over 5% must be approved by the Commission prior to the prospective new owner acquiring the ownership interest. Ms. Snyder did not apply for approval of the transfer and DigiDeal did not notify the Commission of the transfer. However, after consideration, no disciplinary action was taken by the Commission.

Ms. Snyder submitted a Personal Disclosure Form 1 on June 9, 2011. A background and financial investigation was conducted on Ms. Snyder and the Commission found no derogatory information that would affect her suitability.

## **COMMISSION ACTION**

Based on the foregoing, and in accordance with 68 IAC 5-2, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the transfer of a minority ownership interest in DigiDeal to Maryanne Snyder.

The Commission's approval is contingent upon the following: (1) acceptance of the continuing condition that DigiDeal and all relevant affiliates, Key Persons, and Substantial Owners remain in full compliance with all laws, regulations and/or other directives which are applicable to this acquisition, and/or to a supplier licensee in the State of Indiana.
