

**ORDER 2013-043**

**AN ORDER REGARDING THE REQUEST FOR HEARING REGARDING THE  
VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION REMITTANCE OF JOHN DOE #12-31**

On August 2, 2012, in Order 2012-65, the Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) approved remittance of \$18,049.09 against John Doe #31 for the reason that John Doe #31 was a participant in the Voluntary Exclusion Program at the time John Doe #31 was discovered having won a jackpot for \$18,049.09 while in the gaming area of the Ameristar Casino in East Chicago, Indiana.

Subsequently, John Doe #12-31 timely filed with the Commission a request for a hearing on Order 2012-65. Administrative Law Judge Michael Cook was assigned to the case. On January 23, 2013, Commission staff agreed to settle the appeal with John Doe #12-31. The settlement agreement was subsequently approved by the Administrative Law Judge.

**COMMISSION ACTION**

After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with IC 4-21.5-3-29, the Commission hereby:

**AFFIRMS**

the Administrative Law Judge’s Order. Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-6, this Order will become effective fifteen (15) days after it is served.
