ORDER 2013-045

AN ORDER REGARDING THE REQUEST FOR HEARING REGARDING THE VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION REMITTANCE OF JOHN DOE #12-84

On August 2, 2012, in Order 2012-118, the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") approved remittance of \$1,342.74 against John Doe #84 for the reason that John Doe #84 was a participant in the Voluntary Exclusion Program at the time John Doe #84 was discovered having won a jackpot for \$1,342.74 while in the gaming area of the Majestic Star Casino in Gary, Indiana.

Subsequently, John Doe #12-84 timely filed with the Commission a request for a hearing on Order 2012-118. Administrative Law Judge Michael Cook was assigned to the case. On January 11, 2013, an Evidentiary Hearing was held on the matter, which John Doe #11-84 attended. Following the Evidentiary Hearing, Administrative Law Judge Michael Cook issued his confidential Order in the matter, upholding the remittance of the jackpot and effectively recommending a denial of John Doe 11-84's petition for review of Order 2011-118.

COMMISSION ACTION

After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with IC 4-21.5-3-29, the Commission hereby:

AFFIRMS

the Administrative Law Judge's Order. Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-6, this Order will become effective fifteen (15) days after it is served.
