ORDER 2014-202

IN RE REQUEST FOR HEARING TO REVIEW ORDER 2014-16 REGARDING THE REMITTANCE OF WINNINGS BY VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION PROGRAM PARTICIPANT JOHN DOE #14-16

On March 20, 2014, the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") approved Order 2014-16 remitting VEP participant John Doe #14-16's \$1,096.25 winnings pursuant to 68 IAC 6-3-2(g).

On March 31, 2014, John Doe #14-16 timely filed with the Commission a request for a hearing on Order 2014-16. Administrative Law Judge Michael Cook was assigned to the case. On July 11, 2014, Commission staff filed its Motion for Summary Judgment. John Doe #14-16 failed to file a response. Following a telephonic hearing on the Motion for Summary Judgment, in which John Doe #14-16 participated, Administrative Law Judge Michael Cook issued his Confidential Order in the matter, upholding the remittance of the jackpot and effectively recommending a denial of John Doe #14-16's petition for review of Order 2014-16.

After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with IC 4-21.5-3-29, the Commission hereby:

AFFIRMS

the Administrative Law Judge's Confidential Order. Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-6, this Order will become effective fifteen (15) days after it is served.
