## ORDER 2014-210 APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION AND MICHAEL HIATT

On or about March 5, 2014, Michael Hiatt ("Mr. Hiatt") was issued a level 2 temporary license and temporary identification badge to work at Belterra Casino as a Surveillance Agent. During a background investigation, Commission investigators discovered Mr. Hiatt did not meet the standards adopted the Commission for the holding of an occupational license as required by IC 4-33-8-3(4). The Commission requested information from Mr. Hiatt in a letter dated March 13, 2014. Mr. Hiatt failed to respond to this March 13, 2014 letter, necessitating further investigation and requests from the Commission.

An applicant for an occupational license must comply with all requests for information, documents, or other materials relating to the applicant and his application during the investigation conducted by the Commission. 68 IAC 2-3-5(b)(9).

In lieu of disciplinary proceedings, Commission staff and Mr. Hiatt have agreed to settle this matter. The terms of the settlement have been reduced to writing, and in pertinent part, provide that Mr. Hiatt agrees to voluntarily relinquish his temporary license and temporary identification badge for a period of three (3) unpaid regularly scheduled working days, without using vacation or any other paid leave time, in lieu of the initiation of an alternative disciplinary proceeding by the Commission.

Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the proposed terms of the settlement agreement.
