ORDER 2014-87 APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION AND RYAN VIERLING

On or about January 16, 2013, Ryan Vierling ("Mr. Vierling") was issued a level 2 temporary license and temporary identification badge to work at Indiana Grand Casino as a Security Officer. During a background investigation, Commission investigators discovered Mr. Vierling did not meet the standards adopted the Commission for the holding of an occupational license as required by Ind. Code 4-33-8-3-(4). The Commission gave Mr. Vierling several opportunities to meet the standards required by the Commission and to provide the Commission with requested information through letters received by Mr. Vierling on May 17, 2013 and December 26, 2013. Because Mr. Vierling continued to fail to provide the requested information and come into compliance with standards required by the Commission for licensure, his temporary license and identification badge were revoked on April 15, 2014. On, April 16, 2014, Mr. Vierling submitted documentation showing that he had met standards adopted by the Commission for the purpose of licensure.

An applicant for occupational license must comply with all requests for information, documents, or other materials relating to the applicant and her application during the investigation conducted by the Commission. 68 IAC 2-3-5(b)(9).

Commission staff and Mr. Vierling have agreed to settle this matter. The terms of the settlement have been reduced to writing, and in pertinent part, provide that Mr. Vierling agreed to voluntarily relinquish his temporary license and temporary identification badge for a period of six (6) unpaid regularly scheduled working days, without using vacation or any other paid leave time in order to have his temporary license and temporary identification badge reinstated.

Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the proposed terms of the settlement agreement.
