

**RESOLUTION 2015-204**  
**ADOPTING LSA DOCUMENT #15-84 AS A FINAL RULE**

The Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) adopts this resolution pursuant to the authority granted under Ind. Code §§ 4-33-4 and 4-35-4.

The Commission has considered the following factors:

1. Senate Enrolled Act 528, signed by Governor Pence on May 10, 2013, authorized limited mobile gaming systems and devices at Indiana casinos.
2. On February 5, 2015, the Commission received approval from the Office of Management and Budget to promulgate rules concerning limited mobile gaming pursuant to an exception to the Regulatory Moratorium.
3. The Commission began promulgation of LSA Document #15-84 pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-22. The *Indiana Register* posted the LSA Document #15-84 Notice of Intent to Adopt at DIN: 20150408-IR-068150084NIA on April 8, 2015, and the Proposed Rule at DIN: 20150708-IR-068150084PRA on July 8, 2015.
4. The Commission held a public hearing on August 20, 2015 at 10:00AM in compliance with Ind. Code § 4-22. Representatives from Pinnacle Entertainment, Ameristar Casino, and Centaur Gaming attended the hearing. There was one public comment offered by Centaur Gaming at the public hearing. The Commission reviewed the hearing transcript.
5. The Commission received, reviewed, and considered written comments from Gamblit Gaming and Centaur Gaming.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION, THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED:**

**SECTION 1: SCOPE**

This resolution applies to all casino licensees, operating agents, gambling game licensees, supplier licensees, and trustees.

**SECTION 2: DEFINITIONS**

The definitions set forth in Ind. Code § 4-33, Ind. Code § 4-35 and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code apply to this resolution.

**SECTION 3: ADOPTION OF THE FINAL RULE**

The Commission adopts the following rules as reflected on the attached Final Rule document:

**Adds 68 IAC 25.**


Pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-22-2, the Commission approves the attached LSA document #15-84 Final Rule. Commission staff will forward the rule to the Office of the Attorney General for approval as to legality under Ind. Code § 4-22-2-32. Upon approval by the Office of the Attorney General, the rule will be submitted to the Governor's Office for approval pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-22-2-33. After the rule has been approved by the Governor, the rule will be submitted to the *Indiana Register* for filing in accordance with Ind. Code § 4-22-2-35. The Commission further approves and adopts any stylistic, grammatical, typographical, or other non-substantive changes that the Commission staff or the Legislative Services Agency may make to the rule document before it is printed as a final rule in the *Indiana Register*.

**SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE**

This resolution is effective immediately.
