

ORDER 2015-82
AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION
REGARDING THE SETTLEMENT IN
AN EXCLUSION VIOLATION ACTION

On August 20, 2014, Robert Wilson was found in the Hollywood Casino in Lawrenceburg, Indiana in possession of gaming chips valued at \$2,600. At this time Mr. Wilson was a member of the Commission Exclusion list, which barred him from entering the gaming area of any Indiana casino, pursuant to 68 Ind. Admin. Code § 6-1-1. The civil penalty that the Commission may seek for violation of Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code must not exceed the greater of \$1,000 for the first violation or the amount of any jackpot or thing of value won contemporaneous to or because of the excluded individual's violation. 68 Ind. Admin. Code § 13-2-1(b)(1)(A); 68 Ind. Admin. Code § 13-2-1(b)(2).

As a result of the violation, Commission staff initiated an administrative action in order to seize the amount of any jackpot or thing of value won contemporaneous to or because of Mr. Wilson's violation. Commission staff and Mr. Wilson entered into a settlement agreement in the administrative action. The settlement agreement was subsequently approved by the Administrative Law Judge.

After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-29, the Commission hereby:

AFFIRMS

the Administrative Law Judge's Order approving the settlement agreement. Pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-6, this Order will become effective fifteen days after it is served.


