

RESOLUTION 2017-110

A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR AUTHORITY TO RENEW THE FOLLOWING LICENSES AND CONTRACTS:

RIVERBOAT OWNER LICENSE, RACETRACK GAMBLING GAME LICENSE, RIVERBOAT OPERATING AGENT CONTRACT, SUPPLIER LICENSE AND PAID FANTASY SPORTS GAME OPERATOR LICENSE

The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") adopts the following resolution pursuant to authority granted to it under Ind. Code art. 4-33, Ind. Code art. 4-35 and pursuant to 68 IAC 1-2-6. The following factors have been considered by the Commission:

1. Pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-33-6-17 and 68 IAC 2-1-9, a Riverboat Owner's License may be renewed annually upon the payment of a five thousand dollar annual renewal fee and a determination that the licensee satisfies conditions of the Riverboat Gambling Act.
2. Pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-35-5-4, a Racetrack Gambling Game license is required to be renewed five years after the effective date of the license and must be renewed annually thereafter upon payment of one hundred dollars (\$100) per slot machine operated by the licensee and a determination by the commission that the licensee satisfies the conditions of Ind. Code ch. 4-35-5.
3. Pursuant to Ind. Code ch. 4-33-6.5 a Riverboat Operator Agent contract must be renewed every twenty (20) years, must meet all requirements of Ind. Code ch. 4-33-6.5 and the renewal may not exceed twenty (20) years.
4. Pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-33-7-8, 68 IAC 2-2-3 and 68 IAC 2-2-8, a Supplier License may be renewed annually upon the payment of a five thousand dollar annual renewal fee and a determination that the licensee satisfies conditions of the Riverboat Gambling Act and gaming regulations contained in 68 IAC.
5. Pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-33-24-17 and Ind. Code § 4-33-24-15, a Paid Fantasy Sports Game Operator license must be renewed annually upon the payment of a five thousand dollar annual renewal fee and a determination that the licensee satisfies conditions of Ind. Code ch. 4-33-24.
6. 68 IAC 1-2-13 provides that "[t]he commission may waive, alter, or restrict any licensing requirement or procedure if the commission determines that the procedure or requirement is impractical, or burdensome, and such waiver, alteration, or restriction is in the best interest of the public and the gaming industry, and is not outside the technical requirements necessary to serve the purpose of the requirement or procedure."
7. Due to the length of time that may elapse between Commission meetings and the timing of license renewals, it would be in the best interest of the Commission and the licensee to delegate the authority to the Executive Director to renew a Riverboat Owners License, Racetrack Gambling Game license, Riverboat Operating Agent contract, Supplier license

and Paid Fantasy Sports Game Operator license until such time as the Commission holds a meeting and has the opportunity to consider the renewal request.

8. This Resolution supersedes and replaces Resolutions 2003-13, 2006-59 and 2013-069.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION, THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED:

SECTION 1. SCOPE.

This resolution applies to all Riverboat Owners licensees, Racetrack Gambling Game licensee, all parties to a Riverboat Operating Agent contract, Supplier licensees and Paid Fantasy Sports Game Operator licensees and all entities that become such licensees or parties to a Riverboat Operating Agent contract at a later date.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS

The definitions set forth in Ind. Code art. 4-33, Ind. Code art. 4-35 and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code apply to this resolution.

SECTION 3. DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY FOR RENEWAL OF LICENSES OR CONTRACT.

Due to the length of time that may elapse between Commission meetings and the timing of renewals of the licenses and contracts outlined above, the Commission hereby delegates the authority to the Executive Director to renew those licenses and contracts until such time as the Commission is able to hold a meeting and consider the renewal request.

This Resolution supersedes and replaces Resolutions 2003-13, 2006-59 and 2013-069.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This resolution is effective immediately.
