AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION
CONCERNING THE CONFIDENTIAL SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT OF THE
APPEAL OF THE VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION REMITTANCE OF JOHN DOE #16-102


On November 17, 2016, in Order 2016-215, the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") approved remittance of Three Thousand One Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$3,180.00) from John Doe #16-102 for a violation as a participant in the Voluntary Exclusion Program. Specifically, John Doe #16-102 won cash equivalents while in the gaming area of the Belterra Casino in Florence, Indiana.

Subsequently, John Doe #16-102 timely filed an appeal of Order 2016-215. On March 9, 2017, Commission staff agreed to settle the appeal with John Doe #16-102.

Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the proposed terms of the confidential settlement agreement.


