

ORDER 2017-40
AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION
APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT WITH DAVID PETRIE


David Petrie ("Licensee") has held a Level 2 permanent occupational license at the Tropicana Evansville Casino since October 1, 2008, to work as a Slot Service Host. The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") issues occupational licenses to casino employees in positions where interaction with gaming machines is required. On October 15, 2016, Licensee was observed acting in violation of 68 IAC 2-3-9.4.

The Commission is authorized to take action including, but not limited to, revocation, restriction, or suspension of an occupational license at any time the Commission determines that the licensee is in violation of 68 IAC 2-3 or Ind. Code ch. 4-33-8. In lieu of disciplinary action, the Commission has agreed to settle the matter with the Licensee. The terms of the settlement have been reduced to writing and, in pertinent part, provide that Licensee agrees to an unpaid and voluntary relinquishment of Licensee's occupational license and identification badge for a period of ten (10) regularly scheduled working days, without using vacation time or any other paid leave time.

Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the proposed terms of the settlement agreement.
