ORDER 2019-188

IN RE APPEAL OF ORDER 2018-185 REGARDING THE REMITTANCE OF WINNINGS BY VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION PROGRAM PARTICIPANT JOHN DOE #18-76

On December 6, 2018, the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") approved Order 2018-185 remitting VEP participant John Doe #18-76's winnings, or \$62,069.82 jackpot, less applicable taxes, pursuant to 68 Ind. Admin. Code § 6-3-2(g).

On December 21, 2018, John Doe #18-76 timely filed with the Commission an appeal of Order 2018-185. Administrative Law Judge Susan W. Gard was assigned to the case. Following the Commission filing its Confidential Motion for Summary Judgment, Memorandum of Law in Support, and Designation of Evidence, Administrative Law Judge Susan W. Gard issued her Confidential Recommended Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Non-Final Decision in the matter, upholding the remittance of the winnings in Order 2018-185.

After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-29, the Commission hereby:

AFFIRMS

the Administrative Law Judge's Confidential Recommendation. By affirming this the Administrative Law Judge's Recommendation, the Commission hereby incorporates the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and decision in the Administrative Law Judge's Confidential Recommendation. Pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-6, this Order will become effective fifteen (15) days after it is served.
