ORDER 2019-21

AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION CONCERNING THE CONFIDENTIAL SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT OF THE APPEAL OF THE VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION REMITTANCE OF JOHN DOE #18-49

On September 13, 2018, in Order 2018-132, the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") approved the remittance of Six Thousand Three Hundred and Seventy Five Dollars (\$6,375.00) from John Doe #18-49 for a violation as a participant in the Voluntary Exclusion Program. Specifically, John Doe #18-49 won cash equivalents while in the gaming area of the Horseshoe Southern Casino in Elizabeth, Indiana while he was an active member of the Voluntary Exclusion Program.

Subsequently, John Doe #18-49 timely filed an appeal of Order 2018-132. On February 13, 2019, the Commission agreed to settle the appeal with John Doe #18-49 pursuant to its authority under 68 IAC 13-2-9. On February 15, 2019, the Administrative Law Judge issued an Order approving the confidential settlement agreement.

Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the proposed terms of the confidential settlement agreement.
