ORDER 2021-135 AN ORDER PROSPECTIVELY RENEWING THE PAID FANTASY SPORTS GAME OPERATOR LICENSE FOR FANDUEL, INC.

In accordance with and subject to Ind. Code art. 4-33 and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code, the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission"), through Order 2017-65, issued a Paid Fantasy Sports Game Operator License to FanDuel, Inc. ("FanDuel") on June 29, 2017. Pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-33-24-17, the Commission has renewed the license annually since inception. The most recent renewal renewed the license through June 28, 2021.

A Paid Fantasy Sports Game Operator License is valid for a period of one year. Further, in accordance with Ind. Code § 4-33-24-15 and 68 IAC 26-3-10, a Paid Fantasy Sports Game Operator License must be renewed annually along with the payment of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) as an annual renewal fee. On May 27, 2021, FanDuel requested renewal of its Paid Fantasy Sports Game Operator License and submitted the required annual renewal fee. On June 24, 2021, pursuant to a delegation of authority granted by the Commission in Resolution 2019-257, the Executive Director extended the license through a date when the Commission could consider FanDuel's request.

COMMISSION ACTION

Pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-33-24-17, the Commission has found that FanDuel has substantially complied with the directives of Ind. Code art. 4-33 and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code; therefore, FanDuel is suitable to hold a license. The Commission **GRANTS** renewal of FanDuel's Paid Fantasy Sports Game Operator License for a period of one (1) year subject to FanDuel maintaining its operations in substantial compliance with all properly applicable state and local laws including, but not limited to, Commission regulations, resolutions, orders and/or other directives relating to the license or the lawful operation of paid fantasy sports in Indiana. The renewal of FanDuel's Paid Fantasy Sports Game Operator License is valid for a period of one year from June 29, 2021 through June 28, 2022.

According to Ind. Code ch. 4-21.5-3, the order is effective fifteen days after the order is served.
