

## Gaming Commission approves game for Bingo.

**This new game can only be played with a current valid charity gaming Bingo or Festival license.**

### “Lucky Ball”

A “lucky ball” is a letter number combination from the standard bingo game based on **“B”** 1 to 15 **“I”** 16 to 30 **“N”** 31 to 45 **“G”** 46 to 60 **“O”** 61 to 75.

The following are recommended house rules:

A player must select the letter number combination and may use it as a free ball all event long to bingo. The organization should provide a two part validation form that contains a minimum of the following information: First and last name of player (name to be verified by ID at time of bingo), date of event, lucky ball number, and name of operator or worker that sold the lucky ball number. The organization is responsible to maintain the duplicate copy for verification of a bingo. The organization will be responsible to verify the identity of the bingo winner.

Each organization should post the rules that cover the cost and use of the lucky ball. These rules must be conspicuously posted for everyone to observe and read. If requested a copy of the rules must be made available to any player.

Each player may only purchase (1) one lucky ball per event. Multiple players may purchase the same letter number combination.

The lucky ball letter and number combination must be placed on the back of every bingo game sheet—before playing the game.

All bingo paper must be available for review at any time.

No sharing of the numbers, Your NAME must appear on the validation form. ID shown at the time of bingo must match the name on the validation form.

No sharing of the bingo paper or lucky number.

Valid only on the specific bingo or festival event date.

No pre-purchase or reservations allowed.

Validation form for the lucky ball and the bingo pack receipt must be made available at all times.

Lucky ball number will be verified at the time of bingo.

NO exceptions to the rules. All disputes will be settled by the operator in charge of the event. Any deviations to the rules or alterations to the paper may result in disqualification of the player.

Recommended selling price of \$1.00 to \$5.00 dollars.

The following is required reporting...

The lucky ball sales must be shown on the required Bingo or Festival Event Summary report and will be included in the bingo income for that event. In block number 16 "Cookie Jar/Hot Ball/Hot Number/Pickle Jar etc".
