

**ORDER 2024-147**

**AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION CONCERNING THE  
PERMANENT SPORTS WAGERING SERVICE PROVIDER LICENSE OF  
INTERNATIONAL BETTING INTEGRITY ASSOCIATION (IBIA).**

In accordance with and subject to Ind. Code ch. 4-38-6 and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code, the Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) has completed its background and financial investigation of International Betting Integrity Association (“IBIA”) and has determined that IBIA is suitable to receive a permanent sports wagering service provider license.

The issuance of the sports wagering service provider license is conditioned upon continued compliance with the following list of requirements:


- 1) Full compliance with all relevant orders, resolutions, and directives issued by the Commission; and
- 2) Continued compliance with Ind. Code art. 4-38 and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code.

The Commission has determined that IBIA is substantially compliant with Ind. Code art. 4-38 and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code and is suitable to hold a sports wagering service provider license. In accordance with and subject to the conditions set forth herein, the Commission hereby **GRANTS** a sports wagering service provider license to International Betting Integrity Association (IBIA).
