Order 2024-154 involved a settlement agreement with Ainsworth Game Technology. Ainsworth violated the rules for shipping electronic gaming devices. Ainsworth has agreed to a monetary settlement of \$1,500 in lieu of disciplinary action.

## ORDER 2024-155 IN RE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT ARISTOCRAT TECHNOLOGIES, INC. 24-ATI-03

Order 2024-155 involved a settlement agreement with Aristocrat Technologies. Aristocrat violated the rules for shipping electronic gaming devices on three (3) separate occasions. Aristocrat has agreed to a monetary settlement of \$6,000 in lieu of disciplinary action.

## ORDER 2024-156 IN RE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT INTERBLOCK LUXURY GAMING PRODUCTS, LLC. 24-IB-02

Order 2024-156 involved a settlement agreement with Interblock Luxury Gaming Products, LLC. Interblock violated the rules for the vendor log while performing work at Bally's Evansville. Interblock has agreed to a monetary settlement of \$1,500 in lieu of disciplinary action.

### ORDER 2024-157 IN RE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT LNW GAMING, INC. d/b/a LIGHT AND WONDER 24-LNW-02

Order 2024-157 involved a settlement agreement with LNW Gaming, Inc. d/b/a Light and Wonder. Light and Wonder violated the rules for shipping electronic gaming devices. Light and Wonder has agreed to a monetary settlement of \$1,500 in lieu of disciplinary action.

## ORDER 2024-158 IN RE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT SURVEILLANCE SYSTEMS INTEGRATION, INC. 24-SSI-01

Order 2024-158 involved a settlement agreement with Surveillance Systems Integration, Inc. Surveillance Systems Integration failed to disclose and/or falsely stated the company's ownership interests on its initial application in September 2019 and on subsequent renewal applications. The company failed to notify the Commission when it became aware of the inaccurate disclosure. A substantial owner also failed to disclose or falsely stated his relationship to a trust on his initial application in 2019 and on his 2023 renewal application. The substantial owner also failed to notify the Commission when it became aware of the inaccurate disclosure. A trustee also failed to apply or hold a level 1 occupational license since 2019.

Surveillance Systems Integration agreed to a monetary settlement of \$30,000 and within 30 days of approval of the settlement agreement, update all inaccurate information in their licensing applications, update the most recent quarterly ownership report to accurately reflect the current ownership of the company and the Trustee must submit their fully completed level one license application.

Order 2024-159 involved a settlement agreement with Ameristar East Chicago and includes two counts. In count one, Ameristar allowed a minor to access the casino floor (7<sup>th</sup> occurrence in six months). In count two, Ameristar violated the rules for sensitive keys. Ameristar has agreed to a monetary settlement of \$7,500 in lieu of disciplinary action.

## ORDER 2024-160 IN RE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AZTAR INDIANA GAMING CO., LLC d/b/a BALLY'S EVANSVILLE 24-BE-03

Order 2024-160 involved a settlement agreement with Bally's Evansville and includes four counts. In count one, Bally's failed to notify surveillance during the replenishment of two (2) ticket redemption units. In count two, Bally's allowed a minor to access the casino floor on two separate occasions (1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> occurrence in six months). In count three, Bally's violated the rules for sensitive keys on three (3) separate occasions. In count four, Bally's violated the rules for the vendor log. Bally's Evansville has agreed to a monetary settlement of \$8,000 in lieu of disciplinary action.

### ORDER 2024-161 IN RE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BELTERRA RESORT INDIANA, LLC 24-BT-03

Order 2024-161 involved a settlement agreement with Belterra Casino and includes one count. Belterra violated the progressive rules for electronic gaming devices and live gaming devices. Belterra has agreed to a monetary settlement of \$6,500 in lieu of disciplinary action.

## ORDER 2024-162 IN RE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BLUE CHIP CASINO, LLC 24-BC-03

Order 2024-162 involved a settlement agreement with Blue Chip Casino and includes one count. Blue Chip violated the rules for live gaming device fills and credits. Blue Chip has agreed to a monetary settlement of \$6,000 in lieu of disciplinary action.

## ORDER 2024-163 IN RE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT CSI OPERATING COMPANY LLC d/b/a CAESARS SOUTHERN INDIANA 24-CS-03

Order 2024-163 involved a settlement agreement with Caesars Southern Indiana and includes three counts. In count one, Caesars Southern Indiana violated the rules for live gaming device fills on four (4) separate occasions. In count two, Caesars Southern Indiana violated the rules for sensitive keys on two (2) separate occasions. In count three, Caesars Southern Indiana violated the rules for the Voluntary Exclusion Program. Caesars Southern Indiana has agreed to a monetary settlement of \$9,500 in lieu of disciplinary action.

Order 2024-164 involved a settlement agreement with French Lick Resort Casino and includes one count. Order 2024-166 involved a settlement agreement with Harrah's Hoosier Park and includes three counts. In count one, Harrah's Hoosier Park violated the rules for sensitive keys. In count two, Harrah's Hoosier Park violated the rules for live gaming device fills. In count three, Harrah's Hoosier Park violated the rules for the Voluntary Exclusion Program. Harrah's Hoosier Park has agreed to a monetary settlement of \$20,500 and the submission of a corrective action plan for Count One and the ongoing sensitive key issues in lieu of disciplinary action.

Order 2024-167 involved a settlement agreement with Hollywood Lawrenceburg and includes two counts. In count one, Hollywood violated the rules for surveillance by failing to limit access to surveillance areas. In count two, Hollywood violated the rules for live gaming device fills. Hollywood has agreed to a monetary settlement of \$4,500 in lieu of disciplinary action.

### ORDER 2024-168 IN RE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT HORSESHOE HAMMOND, LLC 24-HH-03

Order 2024-168 involved a settlement agreement with Horseshoe Hammond and includes one count. Horseshoe Hammond violated the rules for playing cards. Horseshoe Hammond has agreed to a monetary settlement of \$1,500 in lieu of disciplinary action.

In count three, Horseshoe Indianapolis allowed a minor to obtain access to the casino floor on two (2) separate occasions (2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in six months). In count four, Horseshoe Indianapolis violated the electronic gaming device rules when six (6) devices were found to be operating with revoked software. In count five, Horseshoe Indianapolis violated the rules of the Voluntary Exclusion Program. Horseshoe Indianapolis has agreed to a monetary settlement of \$18,500 in lieu of disciplinary action.
