Waiver Summary

September 25, 2025 Commission Meeting

All Casinos:

- Granted a waiver relieving casinos of the requirement to submit promotions to the Commission for review and approval. 68 IAC 1-12.5-2, 68 IAC 2-6-45(a), (b), (c) & (d), 68 IAC 10-1-6.1(b), (c), (f) & (g).
- Granted a waiver of the requirement that sports wagering operators must have at least one (1) manager level position designated as a level one (1) occupational licensee. 68 IAC 27-2-18
- Granted a waiver allowing occupational licensees the ability to wear their badge on a lanyard. 68 IAC 2-3-5(f)(4)(B) and 68 IAC 2-3-6(3).
- Granted a waiver allowing Security and Surveillance to change shifts during the currency collection process. 24-hour Gaming Operations Plan.

Boyd Gaming – Belterra and Blue Chip:

• Granted permanent approval of a waiver related to the Oasis Loyalty Kiosks.

Caesars Southern Indiana:

• Granted a waiver for surveillance staffing during unique weather events and a casino closure. 68 IAC 12-1-1.7.

Horseshoe Hammond:

• Granted permanent approval of waiver on dedicated surveillance coverage for electronic gaming devices and increased the threshold amount. 68 IAC 12-1-5(f)(6)(A) and 68 IAC 12-1-5(f)(6)(B).

Off Track Betting Facilities - Clarksville, Indianapolis and New Haven:

• Granted a waiver on the requirement to have an applicant's signature on the back side of their licensing badge and approved a modified licensing procedure. 68 IAC 2-3-6(2)(B)

Terre Haute Casino Resort:

• Granted permanent approval to waive the escort requirements for jackpots \$10,000 or less. 68 IAC 15-13-2(d)(6).

Rising Star Casino:

• Granted a waiver for a six-month trial period to allow a dual Director of Surveillance and Security role. 68 IAC 2-3-1.1(b).
