

ORDER 2026-083
AN ORDER TABLING THE NATIONAL COLLEGIATE ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION'S
REQUEST TO PROHIBIT ALL INDIVIDUAL PLAYER PROPOSITION BETTING ON
COLLEGE ATHLETES

In accordance with and subject to Ind. Code art. 4-33, Ind. Code art. 4-35, Ind. Code art. 4-38 and 68 Ind. Admin. Code § 27, the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") has the authority to approve or deny events for sports wagering within the State of Indiana. Pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-38-9-4(b), if a sports wagering body requests the Commission to prohibit making wagers of a particular type, the Commission shall grant the request upon a demonstration of good cause from the sports wagering body. "Good Cause" includes, but is not limited to, information provided by a sports governing body that indicates a credible threat to the integrity of sports wagering that is beyond the control of the sports governing body to preemptively remedy or mitigate. 68 IAC 27-1-2(10).

On March 3, 2026 the National Collegiate Athletic Association's ("NCAA") submitted a request to the Commission to prohibit all individual player proposition bet on college athletes. The NCAA provided documentation in support of their request, made a presentation on their request to the Commission, and were available for questions. Representatives from the sports wagering industry provided documentation in opposition to the request, made a presentation on their position to the Commission, and were available for questions. The Commission, having heard the matter, has elected to deliberate independently and may make further inquiries.

The Commission hereby **TABLES** the request of the NCAA to prohibit all individual player proposition betting on college athletes for a later vote.
