

Waiver Summary

June 25, 2026

Commission Meeting

All Casinos:

1. Relief was granted for Progressive Fund Transfers.
 - a. 68 IAC 2-6-31(b)(3), 68 IAC 2-6-33(a)(2) and Commission Memorandum of November 30, 2009.
2. Moonlighting Memorandum clarification provided
 - a. Moonlighting days increased from 15 to 90.
 - b. Changed the process where one Level 2 licensee replaces another Level 2 licensee from an approval process to a mere notification process.
3. Clarification memorandum regarding the Non-Gaming Level 3 License was provided
4. Changed the requirement for the approval of Social Media Streamers replacing state IGC notification with local IGC Agent notification.

Ameristar Casino

5. 24-hour Gaming Operation Plan variance reducing the number of Surveillance officers during the drop to one designated individual.

Belterra Casino and Blue Chip Casino

6. Removed the requirement for a second verifier of drop boxes during the soft count. Six-month test of this waiver before it becomes permanent state-wide.
 - a. 68 IAC 11-3-6(c)(3)
7. Approved a request to allow two properties to share one Level 1 Sports Wagering Manager
 - a. 68 IAC 27-2-18

Hoosier Park Casino and Horseshoe Indianapolis Casino

8. Progressive Surveillance Coverage requirement was raised from \$50,000 to \$150,000.
 - a. 68 IAC 12-1-5(f)(6)(A)(B)

French Lick Resort

9. 24-hour Gaming Operation Plan variance reducing the number of Security officers during the drop to two designated individuals.

NCAA

10. Waiver granted to the required that supporting documents to an individual's position be provided at least five days prior to the business meeting per 68 IAC 1-2-5.1(c).
