IHCDA has released a <u>Request for Qualifications ("RFQ"</u>) for organizations interested in receiving funding under the HOME Investment Partnerships Tenant Based Rental Assistance ("HOME TBRA") for Second Chance Act ("SCA") Pay for Success for Program Participants program.

The HOME TBRA program can provide rental assistance, security deposits, and utility deposits to income-eligible households. Through this funding opportunity, the recipient will provide HOME TBRA assistance to approximately 35 Formerly Incarcerated Individuals having a household income at or below 60% of AMI who are enrolled in the SCA Pay for Success program.

The Recipient will collaborate with the SCA program service provider, Edna Martin Christian Center, who will provide supportive services for program participants. All program participants will be individuals on parole referred from the Indiana Department of Correction ("IDOC") seeking to live in the Indianapolis zip codes 46218, 46201, 46203, or 46226.

Eligible applicants are nonprofit corporations recognized as tax exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code, public housing agencies, or units of local government.

Responses to the RFQ are due by 5:00PM Eastern Time on Monday, December 9, 2024. IHCDA will host an informational webinar to explain the policies and RFQ on November 12, 2024, at 2:00 PM Eastern Time.
