1. Go to <http://www.fema.gov/hazard/map/firm.shtm>.
2. Click on "Find a FIRM"
3. Enter address to search by street address.
4. Click VIEW.
5. Click "Make a FIRMette."
6. Change page size and print area as necessary.
7. Create FIRMette.
8. Save for your records and print a copy for your ER submission. If you are submitting an electronic copy, please submit as a PDF.
