

Indiana Balance of State 2019 NOFA Internal Competition Frequently Asked Questions:

On the renewal application worksheet, what is the difference between the "points awarded" and "score" columns?

A. Renewal project applicants should enter their scores in the column marked 'score'. The 'Points Awarded' column is for the use of the Review Panel

Under cost effectiveness - what should be included in total project cost? Should it be the HUD award? Award plus required match?

A. This should be based on the HUD award only.

On question 6, "Households who exit to homelessness or unknown", maximum points says 5 but the scoring criteria says "5% or fewer exit to homelessness or unknown = 10 points; 8% or fewer return to homelessness or unknown, 5 points".

A. This is an error, apologies – 5 points is the maximum award – therefore, 5% or fewer exiting to homelessness or unknown = 5 points; Between 5 and 8% exiting to homelessness or unknown, score 3 points.

The attachment labeled 2019 IN0502 standards survey, is that the Renewal Application?

A. Yes. The Excel file and required attachments constitute the renewal application.
