#### Services Provided in Designated Economically Disadvantaged Areas:

- <u>Neighborhood assistance</u> in the form of <u>financial assistance</u>, <u>labor</u>, <u>material</u>, <u>and</u>
   <u>technical advice to aid in the physical or economic improvement</u> of any part or all of an
   economically disadvantaged area.
- Counseling and advice in an economically disadvantaged area.
- Emergency assistance in an economically disadvantaged area.
- <u>Medical care</u> in an economically disadvantaged area.
- Development and/or management of <u>recreational facilities</u> in an economically disadvantaged area.
- Development and/or management of <u>housing facilities</u> in an economically
- Economic development assistance in an economically disadvantaged area.

## Services Provided to Individuals LIVING IN Designated Economically Disadvantaged Areas:

- <u>Job training</u> that provides individuals living in an economically disadvantaged area with vocational skills so that they can become employable or able to seek a higher grade of employment.
- <u>Education</u>, in the form of scholastic instruction or scholarship assistance, that enables
  individuals living in an economically disadvantaged area to prepare for better life
  opportunities.
- Crime prevention or reduction activities in an economically disadvantaged area.

#### **Services for Economically Disadvantaged Households:**

- <u>Job training</u> that provides individuals in economically disadvantaged households with vocational skills so that they can become employable or able to seek a higher grade of employment.
- Crime prevention or reduction activities in economically disadvantaged households.

# Services Provided Specifically for Individuals who are Ex-Offenders Who Have Completed their Criminal Sentences or are Serving a Term of Probation or Parole:

- <u>Job training</u> that provides ex-offenders with vocational skills so that they can become employable or able seek a higher grade of employment.
- Education, in the form of scholastic instruction or scholarship assistance,
- Counseling and advice for ex-offenders.
- Emergency assistance for ex-offenders.
- Medical care for ex-offenders.
- Development and/or management of <u>recreational facilities</u> for ex-offenders.
- Development and/or management of housing facilities for ex-offenders.

#### Other Eligible Services:

• <u>Neighborhood assistance</u> in the form of <u>technical advice to promote higher employment</u> in any neighborhood in Indiana.
