Re: Notice of filing to amend the 2019 Action Plan

Notice is hereby given that the Indiana Housing and Community Development Authority (IHCDA) plans to amend the 2019 Action Plan for the Emergency Solutions Grant CARES Act (ESG-CV) funding in response to community needs associated with the COVID-19 pandemic. This funding is used to fund activities designed to prevent, prepare, and respond to COVID19 throughout the Indiana Balance of State.

This notice concerns the allocation and administration of ESG-CV funds:

- 1) IHCDA will utilize up to \$2,500,000 for any activities outlined for RRH/Homeless Prevention.
- 2) In cases where subrecipient capacity is strained, IHCDA will assume the role of direct services provider. This option will apply statewide and not specific to any one region, to allow flexibility for adding capacity to respond to increased demand, as needed.

This funding provided a supplemental appropriation of Homeless Assistance Grants under the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) as authorized by McKinney Vento Homeless Assistance Act of 1987 (P.L. 100-77), as amended by the Homeless Emergency Assistance and Rapid Transition to Housing (HEARTH) Act of 2009 (P.L. 111-22) (42 U.S.C.S.§11371 et. seq.)
