Re: Request for Proposals – Request for Proposals - Coordination with IHCDA and the Indiana Balance of State CoC to Implement a Qualitative/Quantitative Statewide Youth and Young Adult (YYA) Needs Assessment

The Indiana Housing and Community Development Authority (“IHCDA”) seeks to contract with a consultant to conduct a qualitative and quantitative homeless youth statewide needs assessment. This initiative is in response to the BoS CoC 2023-2025 strategic plan to empower people with lived experience and to address the needs of underrepresented Hoosiers: in this case, youth and young adults (YYA).as detailed in the Scope of Services section of this RFP.

The primary goal of this study is to develop and conduct a qualitative and quantitative statewide homeless youth needs assessment that identifies factors that put young people most at risk of housing insecurity and homelessness. This study will include information specific to Marion County and the City of South Bend, both of whom are identified partners particularly interested in examining youth homelessness in their region. This needs assessment is funded from the Youth Homelessness Systems Improvement grant, awarded to IHCDA in June 2024.
