Multiple areas of Indiana were affected by severe storms and flooding during the week of August 9, 2026. In response, IHCD A is offering disaster assistance to households who were displaced from their homes in [counties that have a disaster declaration](#). **Displaced households must call Indiana 211 to be assessed and referred to IHCD A for assistance.**

The first graphic below summarizes IHCD A's disaster hotel assistance and rental assistance programs. The second graphic lists other types of referrals and resources that 211 may be able to provide. IHCD A encourages its partners to help spread this information in their communities.

Hotel & Temporary Rental Assistance for Hoosiers Affected by Recent Flooding and Storms

IHCDA's disaster assistance offers two options to support households displaced by recent flooding and storms in Indiana. An eligible household must select only one of the two options.

The first step in the process is to call 211 to report your damage and be assessed. 211 will make referrals to IHCDA for clients who may qualify for IHCDA's assistance programs.

Hotel Assistance

Approved households are eligible for a hotel stay for up to 30 days with no extensions. If a household is able to return home sooner, the hotel assistance will end at that time.

Eligibility

Eligibility is based on being displaced from your home as a direct result of the storms and flooding that occurred the week of August 9, 2026., and being located in a county that is included in the recent disaster declaration.

Displaced means that their home is not currently safe or habitable.

Rental Assistance

Approved households who cannot return to their home may choose rental assistance to move to a new rental unit.

IHCDA covers:

- the application fee
- one month's rent (not to exceed the HUD published Fair Market Rent based on the county and unit size)
- the security deposit (not to exceed the lesser of the deposit amount in the lease or two times the Fair Market Rent for the unit).

NOTE: If the actual cost of rent is higher, the household is responsible for the difference.
