Subject: High Energy Use and High Energy Burden Priority Points

BACKGROUND

10 CFR 440.16 stipulates that priority be given to identifying and providing weatherization assistance to:

- (1) Elderly persons;
- (2) Persons with disabilities;
- (3) Families with children;
- (4) High residential energy users; and
- (5) Households with a high energy burden.

In an effort to accomplish this, IHCDA created a point system in which elderly persons, persons with disabilities, and families with children were assigned one point each; high residential energy users and households with a high energy burden were each assigned two points.

NEW GUIDANCE

All five categories will be assigned one point each.

This will not impact any home that has already been weatherized; however, for any home in the waitlist or a home that will be moved to the waitlist in the future, the points will be re-calculated. In the event a subrecipient has already contacted a client, and their points change, please continue communication with that client.
