Officers work on a hourly basis

- o Any additional hours outside your normal scheduled time are considered overtime
- o Patrol officers work 12 hour shifts
 - Days
(5:30 am – 5:30 pm / 6:30 am – 6:30 pm)
 - Nights
(5:30 pm– 5:30 am / 6:30 pm– 6:30 am)
- o Specialty units work 8 and 10 hour shifts; the times for these vary

Overtime

- o Recorded as time and a half
- o Can be taken as pay or comp time
- o Numerous opportunities available, including festivals, concerts, hospital security, and patrol shifts

Training

8 week orientation program
 16 week field training program
 Various refresher and new courses offered throughout year

Benefits

Retirement

- o Defined Benefit Plan Pension
- o 2.0% multiplier, with option to purchase up to a 2.8% multiplier after 6 months of service
(Ex: 2.8% multiplier equals 80% maximum pension benefit at approximately 28.5 years of service)
- o ICMA 457 plan option

Insurance

- o Health/Vision/Dental/Life (Optional)

Vacation Time

- o Start with 80 hours of vacation
- o 8 hours accrued for each year, thereafter (maximum of 200 hours)
- o Up to 320 hours can carry over from year to year
- o 12 paid holidays

Sick Time

- o 8 hours of sick time are awarded for each month of service
- o An unlimited amount can carry over
- o 1,265 hours sick time counts toward 1 year of pension credit at retirement

Maternity/Paternity Leave

- o Up to 80 hours of paid leave
- o Does not count against vacation time or sick time

Hiring Process

- Apply online at www.joiningrpd.com
- Civil Service Exam
- Complete and submit background questionnaire within 10 days of receiving
- Background Pre-screen
- Oral Board Interviews
- Backgrounds Assigned
- Background Investigation and Interview Completed
- Chiefs and Administrative Review
- Chiefs Interviews
- Recommendations for Hire
- Conditional Offer of Employment
- Physical and Psychological Exam

Requirements

- Must be at least 18 years old
- Must have a high school diploma or GED
- Possess good moral character
- Possess good reading and writing skills
- Possess a valid driver's license
- Be a U.S. Citizen
- Have a record clear of any felonies and certain misdemeanors
- Have successfully completed a MCOLES accredited police academy, be a MCOLES Certified Police Officer, or have completed a MCOLES RPTE (Recognition of Prior Training and Experience) class for out of state officers

Job Description

- Respond to emergency and non-emergency calls for service
- Take criminal and non-criminal reports
- Follow-up and investigate crimes which have occurred
- Conduct proactive enforcement
 - Traffic stops
 - Directed policing related to area crime
 - Canvassing neighborhoods for issues citizens are having
 - Conduct business checks and form relationships with staff
- Participate in community policing by conducting non-enforcement contact with citizens and attending community events
- Assist other agencies, as needed
- Arrest and lodge suspects
- Testify in court
- Participate in continuous department-wide training
- Available to work nights, weekends, and holidays
