The Avon Police Department is currently accepting pre-applications for the position of a sworn police officer with the Town of Avon. The pre-application process takes less than a minute to complete. Applicants may enroll at the Town of Avon website located at www.avongov.org.

QUALIFICATIONS

- United States Citizen
- High School diploma or equivalent (GED)
- Be at least 21 years of age, but under 36 years of age
- Have the ability to obtain, and must have obtained, a valid Indiana Driver's license
- Be insurable through the Town of Avon's current liability policy
- Be free of mental illness as defined by the Indiana Public Employees Retirement Fund
- Be physically fit as defined by the Indiana Public Employees Retirement Fund
- Have the ability to be bonded
- Be able to read and write the English language
- Not have been discharged from the United States Military under less than honorable conditions
- Be of good moral character
- Be able to legally possess and carry a firearm
- Be a resident of Hendricks County, Indiana or a county contiguous to Hendricks County, Indiana, or, at the time of hiring, demonstrate intent to reside within such area within 6 months of hire date and then actually become a resident of such area within such time

Physical agility testing will be conducted at the Indiana Law Enforcement Academy in Plainfield and the written examination will be administered at Avon Middle School South in Avon.
