CAMP ATTERBURY JOINT MANEUVER TRAINING CENTER Approval Process for Live Fire Maneuver Exercises and Live Fire Shoot House Exercises

- 1. The process for approval of a maneuver live fire and live fire shoot house request is as follows:
 - Units will request the Range through Camp Atterbury Scheduling utilizing CA Form 350-1.
 - b. Units or organizations planning to conduct a LFMX or LFSH Exercise must begin to coordinate the plan and scenario for the exercise with Range Control NLT 90 days in advance of the planned exercise. This will ensure availability of resources. If this window is not met then the request may be denied.
 - Units will request the Range through Camp Atterbury Scheduling utilizing CA Form 350-1.
 - d. Units must contact the Camp Atterbury Scheduling office at 812-526-1678 in order to procure the proper documents and information necessary to build their live fire packet.
 - e. Units must reference and comply with CA Reg 385-63, chapter 19 and 20 when constructing their live fire packet.
 - Live Fire Shoot House Packets will coordinate their exercise and packet through Range Control and RTLP.
 - f. The completed packet will be submitted to the Range Control Live Fire Safety Coordinator, Air ops coordinator, Assistant Chief of Ops, Range Control Officer, and the Current Ops Chief for completeness and compliance.
 - g. The approved packet is presented to the DPTM
 - Range Control Officer for final RFMSS approval.
 - Range Manager, for target support and operator training requirements. It is essential to insure proper targets etc. are available.
 - Range Control NCOIC to arrange for support by Range Control
 - h. The completed and reviewed packet will then be submitted to the Current Operations Chief for final approval.
