Section 2.3 of the <u>INDOT Protected Species Guidance</u> lists the minimum qualifications to perform the different levels of inspections and studies to determine the evidence of bat use of a structure and subsequent work required.

The minimum requirement to perform environmental bridge/structure inspections is the completion of the online INDOT bat field investigation training.
