The Indiana Department of Transportation intends to proceed with a project involving the aforementioned demolition in Franklin County. This letter is part of the early coordination phase of the environmental review process. We are requesting comments from your area of expertise regarding any possible environmental effects associated with this project. **Please use the above designation numbers and description in your reply.** We will incorporate your comments into a study of the project's environmental impacts.

This project is the demolition of house and garage at the corner of US 52 and SR1 (1148 Main Street) in the city of Brookville. Demolition of the house and garage would involve the physical property to be removed to a depth of one foot below original ground level. The basement floor will be broken up and filled with b-borrow. The property will be graded and seeded. Tress larger than six inches in diameter will remain on the property.

Land use in the vicinity of the project primarily consists of the residential and business.





Figure 1. The location of Franklin County within the state of Indiana





