

WELCOME

Virginia Avenue and Fletcher Avenue Bridge Improvements



— PROJECT OVERVIEW —



INDOT is replacing the decks on both the Virginia Avenue and Fletcher Avenue bridges over I-65 and I-70 in downtown Indianapolis. Construction is expected to begin in early 2027 and last up to two years.

IMPROVEMENTS INCLUDE:

- New bridge decks and railings
- Repaired concrete, sidewalks, and barriers
- Improved safety features (Virginia Avenue bridge)
- Updated traffic detectors (Fletcher Avenue bridge)

— WHAT TO EXPECT —




- Virginia Avenue bridge closes first for improvements; Fletcher Avenue bridge to follow in 2028 (tentative)
- Each bridge closure to last about eight months
- Indianapolis Cultural Trail temporarily closed with pedestrian detour
- Signed detours to guide cars, bikes and pedestrians

Calvary Street, Fletcher Avenue, Shelby Street/Woodlawn Avenue

FLETCHER AVENUE DETOUR:

Virginia Avenue/College Avenue, Calvary Street
